## ABATEPAC's Candidate Endorsements Are Based *Solely* On Motorcycle/Motorcyclist-Related Issues

### HOW ABATEPAC SELECTED SENATE, ASSEMBLY & CONGRESSIONAL CANDIDATES FOR ENDORSEMENT —

ABATEPAC has carefully considered all of the incumbent and challenging candidates for the above offices. With rare exceptions, the Committee conformed to the following guidelines:

1. In races involving an incumbent with a record of supporting Motorcyclists' freedom of choice and road safety, ABATEPAC has endorsed the incumbent.

2. In races involving an incumbent with a record of

opposing Rider freedom of choice and road safety, ABATEPAC has endorsed the challenger if he or she favorably answered a series of motorcyclist-related issue questions. Otherwise, the Committee has made no endorsement.

3. In races where there is no incumbent, ABATEPAC has endorsed one, both, or neither candidate on an evaluation of their answers to a number of motorcyclist-related issue questions.

### *If You Are Unsure Who Represents You:*

This is the first election since the District maps were changed following the 2010 General Election. This election will follow the new maps. Go to the Secretary of State's list of *County Elections Offices* at [www.sos.ca.gov/elections/elections\\_d.htm](http://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/elections_d.htm) and call your county's Elections Office to get the District Numbers for your address.

*Find Your Voting District. Then, Contact ABATEPAC's Endorsed Candidate(s) to Volunteer to work to get them elected; Don't Forget to Vote for them on Election Day, Tuesday, November 6. (If two boxes are listed for the same District, ABATEPAC has endorsed both candidates.)*
