There are a few ways for the citizens of our nation to directly affect the way government operates and how its results affect us. The most important of these is regular participation in the electoral process. With this in mind, ABATE of California, through its political arm, ABATEPAC, has produced this nonpartisan Voter Guide.

The intent of this guide is to aid motorcyclists, and others interested in individual freedom and liberty, in making informed choices at the polls on November 4, 2014.

ABATE of California supports the interests of California's more than one million motorcycle riders and passengers. ABATE promotes rider training and education, driver awareness programs, and other projects that make the road safer for everyone.

How ABATEPAC Selected Senate, Assembly & Congressional Candidates for "Endorsement". ABATEPAC has carefully considered all of the incumbent and challenging candidates for the offices. With rare exceptions, the Committee conformed to the following guidelines:

1. In races involving an incumbent with a record of supporting motorcyclist's freedom of choice and road safety, ABATEPAC has usually endorsed the incumbent. In some cases the challenger has answered the questions all favorably and is also recommended.
2. In races involving an incumbent with a record of opposing Rider freedom of choice and road safety, ABATEPAC has endorsed the challenger if he or she favorably answered a series of motorcyclist-related issue questions. Otherwise, the Committee has made no endorsement.
3. In races where there is no incumbent, ABATEPAC has endorsed one, both, or neither candidate on an evaluation of their answers to a number of motorcyclist-issue related questions.
4. When the Committee has endorsed neither candidate in a race, it has available each candidate's answers to the questionnaire, IF the questionnaire was answered.

Find your Voting District. Then contact ABATEPAC's endorsed Candidate(s) to Volunteer to work to get them elected; Don't forget to Vote for them on Election Day, Tuesday, November 4th. (If two candidate's names are listed for the same District, ABATEPAC has endorsed both candidates.)
